We can be as sure as the unbreakable promises of God. He has promised the gift of an eternal life to






Sunday School and Adult Bible Class are held each Sunday at 10:15 a.m.






More landscaping on the west side of church was done last month. Thank you to all those that helped and donated to this project. It looks great!
